Dr. Merry Texter passed away peacefully on August 11, 2019 at age 84. Born on Christmas Day, 1934 in Orange, Ohio, she was the youngest of 6 children.

She received her Bachelor's, Master's and PhD in Music Education from the Ohio State University and was a lifelong OSU fan. She taught music in the Mentor, Ohio school district for over 30 years, retiring to Sarasota in the mid 1980's. After retirement she continued to conduct and perform as a member of the Suncoast Concert Band.

She is survived by a nephew, Eric Hess of Rocky River, Ohio. She was preceded in death by her parents, Nellie and Marion Texter, siblings Helen, Ruth, Jean, Ben and Lee, and her best friend Patricia Matthews, who passed away in 2012.
