Aleta R. Blachly, 94, passed away peacefully at Harbor Chase of Sarasota Wednesday night, August 19, 2020.

A native of Reading, Pennsylvania, Aleta went to business school in Reading to learn secretarial skills, and then worked as a secretary for a dairy business. She was volunteering for the U.S.O. when she met Joseph H. Blachly of Forrest City, Missouri who would become her life's partner in marriage for 53 years until he passed in 2000. Together they moved to Columbia, Missouri where Aleta was the secretary to the Dean of Dairy Science at the University of Missouri while Joseph attended school. The Blachly's called several states home, including Missouri, Maryland, Minnesota, Wisconsin, and Ohio before settling in Sarasota in 1983.

During those years she and Joseph raised four children, David A. Blachly residing in Dallas, Texas with his partner Deborah Collins; Nancy E. Blachly formerly residing in Tahoe, California; Dennis K.
