Alice Kraus Rabinowitz, 93, died on November 8, 2024 in Sarasota, FL. She was born on March 28, 1931, in Halifax, Nova Scotia and was raised in Owen Sound, Ontario; Fredericton, New Brunswick; Lima, Ohio; and Terre Haute, Indiana.
