ALMA JANE STREET FLECK, age 90, of North Port, Florida, passed away on Tuesday 25 July, 2023 at North Port Pines Nursing home in North Port, FL. She was the widow of Paul Henry Fleck, of Quakertown, Pennsylvania.

Born in Camden, NJ, she was the daughter of the late Virginia Keane Street. Her father the late Samuel S. Street was a Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Army.

Alma earned her associates degree at Penn State University. She was a full-time mother to her three children, she worked at Hess's Department Store in Quakertown, PA and later was a full-time nanny for a few families in the Allentown PA area. She loved children therefore after retirement became a foster grandmother for Children First and the Pines Day Care Center in Sarasota, FL. She only stopped caregiving when her health was declining.

phone calls and yearly gatherings to spend time together. Later in life, she continued to enjoy spending time with her new friends in Sarasota, FL especially enjoying lunches out, writing letters, or playing cards and bingo.

Caldwell, NJ; one daughter, Virginia "Ginni" Fleck and her husband Scott Watson of Amsterdam, Netherlands; three grandchildren, Robert, Jake and Abigail Fleck and three great-grandchildren, Kayden, Bella and Noah.
