Archie Thomas Lasater, 89, passed away on Sunday, February 11, in Bradenton, Florida. He was born September 8, 1928 and raised by the loving Merrill and Gertie Randall in Puryear, Tennessee. When he was 18 years old, Archie moved to Homer, NY where he was drafted by the United States Army and fought for our country during the Korean War.
