



## Blevins C. Dunklin, Jr.

October 3, 1933 - November 5, 2017

Blevins Coke Dunklin, Jr. passed away peacefully in his home at 1:05 am on Sunday morning, November 5th, 2017.

Blev was born in Bronxville, New York on October 3rd, 1933. He is survived by his daughter, Annette Dunklin, his son, Thomas Bang Dunklin, his sister, Anne Madden, and his nephew, Steve Madden, as well as his granddaughter, Eva Rose Dunklin Floyd.

Blev graduated from Bronxville High School and went on to college at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, where he studied Chemical Engineering and graduated with a degree in Business. He became a stockbroker for Clark Dodge and worked on Wall Street for a few years. In 1961, he met the love of his life, Edda Bang, from Oslo, Norway.

Within two years, they had two children, and were ready to move to the suburbs. They moved to Darien, Connecticut in 1966, where Blev soon started his own business as a Financial Analyst. In 1996, he and Edda moved to Sarasota, Florida, ready for retirement, golf and tennis, and meeting new friends.

When Edda became ill with Parkinson's Disease and Lewy Body Dementia, he became her devoted primary care giver until she passed away on

December 16th, 2012.
