



Dr. Carlos Augusto Romero

November 24, 1945 - October 5, 2023

In loving memory of Dr. Carlos Augusto Romero, of Brookville, N.Y. and Sarasota, FL., who peacefully passed away surrounded by his family on October 5, 2023, at the age of 77. Born November 24, 1945, in Buenos Aires, Argentina, Carlos was a remarkable man as well as a renowned physician.

His dedication to his profession and the care he gave so generously to all his patients, led him to establish both new medical and surgical treatment options, available to all.

In 1975, Dr. Romero was the Physician in Charge for the Development of the Hyperalimentation Division, thereby developing the Total Parenteral Nutritional Department at Winthrop University Hospital, Mineola, N.Y.

Dr. Romero was a pioneer in introducing Laparoscopic Surgery to the surgical community. In 1990, he performed the first Laparoscopic Guided Cholecystectomy at Winthrop University Hospital as well as the first Laparoscopic Guided Colon Resection, also performed at Winthrop University Hospital. Thereafter, he traveled to many other esteemed institutions to teach other surgeons this new and innovative surgical approach.

Dr. Romero's contributions in the field of medicine were widely recognized and he was awarded the prestigious "Castle Connolly Top Doctors Award" for more

than 15 consecutive years, He was also awarded New York Metro Area's Top Doctors numerous times as well as the New York Metro Area's: Most Compassionate Doctor Award.

Carlos Romero was deeply loved by his family, who meant the world to him.

He is survived by his devoted wife of 45 years, Joan, and his two adoring children, Paul and Victoria, as well as his sister, Maria Luz Romero, who resides in Argentina.

To know Carlos was to experience an extraordinary blend of wisdom, charisma and curiosity. Conversations with him were captivating, as his vast knowledge and diverse interests knew no boundaries. From studying maritime aviary behavior, to nurturing his garden, and from analyzing military strategies of World War 11 to passionately supporting the New York Jets, Carlos lived his life with unbridled enthusiasm.

His lifelong dream came true when he witnessed the national team of Argentina triumph in the World Cup in 2022, alongside his son, a cherished memory that brought him immense joy.

Carlos Romero was a man of many passions and a true lover of life. His profound loss leaves a void in our hearts that cannot be filled. We take solace in the memories we shared and the impact he had on all who knew him.
