Charles Joseph Yuskavage passed away peacefully April 21 at home in Sarasota Florida just a few weeks shy of his 91st birthday. He was the oldest son of Charles Yuskavage and Elizabeth Izzo, whose parents immigrated from Poland and Italy. Charles was born in White Haven, Pennsylvania in 1931 and moved with his parents and his brother to Philadelphia in the 1940's. After graduating from Northeast High School in 1949, he joined the U.S. Marine Corps where he served during the Korean War. While still in the Marines, he married Mary Duffy from New York City whom he had earlier met while she was visiting her cousin in Philadelphia.

Charles was a hard worker who took his responsibilities seriously. He had a kind heart and went out of his way to make life easier for others. He was a letter carrier in the U.S. Postal Service from 1967 until he retired in the early '90s and was loved by all on his route. In 1999, Mary and Charles moved to Sarasota where Charles worked around his new house, cooked wonderful meals at the holidays for his extended family, and took care of Mary during her last years. Charles also took very good care of his cat Casey. He was a cat lover all his life and Casey was with him right until the end.

Charles is survived by his son Robert Emmett (Paula), grandchildren Alexander (Shannon), Julia (Mark), and Timothy (Krystal), great-grandchildren Anna and Simon, sisters-in-law Theresa Linekin, Margaret Freund, and Marie

Yuskavage, and many beloved nieces and nephews. He was pre-deceased by his wife Mary in November 2020 and by his brother in August 2021. Charles' family would like to thank Patricia Winsor for her dedicated and loving care over his last several months. A private viewing will be held at Toale Brothers funeral home in Sarasota.

Heaven is better for him

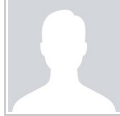
