



Colonel William Steinberg, U.S. Army (Retired)

Bill Steinberg, age 90 of Sarasota, passed away on Saturday, October 20th. Born in Lancaster, Pennsylvania on December 29th, 1927 he was the son of the late Rev. Victor and Florence (Tappe) Steinberg and brother of Pauline Williman. Bill attended Mercersburg Academy and graduated West Point Academy class of 1950. He went directly to the Korean War to serve as a Second Lieutenant where he was awarded The Silver Star. Bill then served two tours in The Vietnam War as a Lieutenant Colonel. Bill Steinberg served as the aide to General Creighton Abrams, commander of Military Operations in Vietnam. He was active duty military for 28 years, also serving as Post Commander in Seoul, Korea. Colonel Steinberg was a highly decorated soldier with numerous Purple Heart Medals, Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal among many others. After he retired, his favorite past time was sailing- having sailed most of his life on the Chesapeake Bay, Caribbean, and West Florida. He will be remembered for his charismatic sense of humor, joy of life, love of his family, and the Florida State Seminoles. The Colonel will be sadly missed by his loving wife of 52 years, Marie-Claire, his daughters Charisse Steinberg, Jeannette Schuyler, and Kiki Bowers as well as his 2 grandchildren.
