Cyrus (Chuck) Field Judson III, 84, of Sarasota, Florida, passed away peacefully on August 20, 2017. He was born on November 19, 1932, in New York, NY, the son of Cyrus Field Judson, Jr. and Virginia Walton Judson.

Chuck is survived by his wife, Barbara; his sister, Virginia Judson Thornburgh; three children, Lawrence Judson, Donna Dimeo, Jacqueline Stevens; and four grandchildren.

As a devoted father, he raised his children to be loving, self-sufficient, and caring, and they have nothing but great memories of their time with him.
