



Darrah Chauvin Bagley

December 11, 1920 - December 30, 2016

Mrs. Darrah Chauvin Bagley of Sarasota, FL, passed away on Friday, December 30, 2016 at the age of 96.

Darrah was an only child born to parents A. Reuben and Louise D. Chauvin on December 11, 1920 in Houma, LA. Darrah and her parents moved to New Orleans in 1931 where she attended the Isadore Newman School and graduated in 1940 from Tulane University with a degree in English.

She met John (Jack) Bagley, a Boston College graduate, at the 1941 Sugar Bowl in New Orleans. They married at her parents' home in New Orleans two years later in 1943.

Jack, who passed away in October 2013 at the age of 94, was a special agent in the FBI for 28 years.

Darrah, Jack and their four children, L. Darrah (deceased), William, Andrew, and J. Christopher, moved across the country residing in Detroit, Syracuse, Washington D.C., New Orleans, Monterey, CA, and Ridgewood NJ.

Jack and Darrah moved to Sarasota in 1987 where they volunteered regularly at Meals on Wheels.

A funeral mass will be said for Darrah and Jack on Saturday, April 22 at 10 am at St. Michael's the Archangel on Siesta Key in Sarasota.

They will be buried in the family plot at the Lake Lawn Metairie Cemetery in Metairie LA.
