David Lee Bixler ("Flounder") of Sarasota, FL, age 48, passed away peacefully with his loving family at his side after a 6 month battle with Pancreatic Cancer.

David Lee was born in Sarasota and graduated from Sarasota High School in 1988 with honors. He then attended The University of Florida and graduated with honors in 1994 with a Bachelor's Degree in Recreation & Tourism. He also received an award from the Dean for Leadership. He was very proud to be part of the Gator Nation.

After college, David Lee worked in the hotel industry, and became a General Manager of a hotel at the young age of 29. After that, his love of motorcycles brought him back to his grandfather Hap's business, Hap's Cycle Sales. He first worked in the parts department, then motorcycle sales, and then became the General Manager. He loved riding and helping others with their dream of owning a motorcycle. He rode starting at the age of 4, and his most memorable enduro race was at age 12 with his Grandfather Hap by his side. At age 60, Hap didn't think he could finish the race, but David Lee encouraged him and he was able to finish.

David Lee is survived by his loving wife, Sara Watler Bixler; his son, Gavin Bixler; his parents, David Bixler and Alice Poneleit Bixler; his brother, Stephen Bixler (Wyanda); his nephews, Christopher, Jacob and Tyler Bixler; and
