



Dean Frederic Bock

July 9, 1930 - January 21, 2017

Dean F. Bock, 86, died peacefully in Sarasota, Florida, on Jan. 21, 2017.

Born in Watertown, New York, he was the son of the late George Frederic Bock and the late Marjorie Burnham Bock. Dean graduated from Deerfield Academy in 1948 and from Cornell University in 1952. He also received an MBA from Cornell in 1956. He served in the US Army from 1952 to 1954 in Japan. Dean moved his family to New Canaan, Ct. in 1956.

He was a Vice President at Kidder, Peabody & Co. from 1956 – 64. He was President Director General of Kidder, Peabody in Paris from 1964 – 68. He was VP and Manager International Dept. from 1968 – 1979. He joined Manufacturers Hanover Bank, New York, in 1979 as Vice President International until retirement in June 1991.

Dean and Barbara retired to Sarasota in 1992. He was a member of The Field Club, past president of the Cornell Club, past president of the Ivy League Club, and a 15 year volunteer at Mote Marine.

Dean is survived by his wife of 63 years, Barbara Green Bock, his four children Marjorie (Gary) Klar, Dean F. Bock Jr., Elizabeth (Gareth) Fancher, and Malcolm Green Bock (Tracy Connor) and his grand children: Rebecca Klar (Timothy) Senter, Leigh Klar, Gareth Malcolm Fancher, Seeley Bock
