Diane Nightingale, 80, of Bradenton Florida and formerly of Medfield Massachusetts, passed away on March 15, with her beloved husband of 62 years, William (Bill) Nightingale, by her side.

Diane was born in Brooklyn New York. She attended Catholic School in Brooklyn and later Hunter High School in Manhattan. She married in 1956. Diane and Bill moved to Medfield in 1965.

Diane had a very successful twenty-year career in real estate in Medfield. She held the distinction of being a certified residential specialist and served on the Greater Boston Real Estate Arbitration Board.

Diane had a passion for social justice, demonstrated in her volunteer activities within the town of Medfield, including working as a Reading specialist in the schools, serving as President of the Medfield League of Women's Voters and serving on the Board of the Medfield Housing Authority. For several years, Diane was responsible for the Voter Information Service for the Massachusetts League of Women Voters. Always politically active, Diane worked on many democratic campaigns and was the election supervisor for her district in Bradenton, FL.

Diane was a wonderful wife, mother and friend. In addition to her husband, she leaves behind many loving family members and friends, including daughter and son-in-law Donna Nightingale and Rick Bacchiocchi, son Bill Nightingale, daughter and son-in-law Jeanne and Mark Teresi, son and daughter-in-law Tom and Lisa Nightingale, Swedish son and daughter-in-law

Anders and Lena Peteri, as well as six grandchildren and one great grandchild.
