He served during WWII in the USNCTC, 75th Construction Battalion, aka SeaBees, in the Solomon Islands and Philippines and was honorably discharged in 1946. He graduated from high school in 1943 and completed his studies by taking advantage of the GI Bill to attend Washington University and earned a BS in Retailing in 1949.
