Dominick Monge, of Sarasota, Florida, passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, March 16, 2016.

Mr. Monge was born May 20, 1918 to Julio and Annetta Monge of Mark, Illinois. He was preceded in death by his wife of 65 years, Gloria (Brian) Monge; he is survived by a brother, Raymond Monge of Dallas, TX.

The Monges had four children, Greg (Sharon) of Ashland, KY, Geoff (Pat) of Monticello, FL, Dee (Linda) of Fairfield, IL, and Nique (Earl) Roosa of Orangeburg, NY. They had 10 grandchildren and 9 great-grandchildren.

Upon retirement he returned to Fairfield and wintered in Sarasota.

Mr. Monge was an active member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Sarasota, as well as the First United Methodist Church and many civic organizations in Fairfield.

Mr. Monge was a principled and devout Christian who will be missed by his family and all who knew him.
