



## Donald L. Faust, Sr.

Donald L. Faust, Sr., 87, of Boyertown, PA and Sarasota, Florida passed away on September 15, 2017 in Sarasota after a brief illness.

Don was a U.S. Army Korean War vet.

He had an impressive career as a civil engineer working for Boeing Aircraft prior to founding Universal Concrete Products in 1967, which started in Stowe PA and, through his grit and determination, grew to include plants in Waco, TX, Laredo, TX, Sarasota FL, Kissimmee, FL, Savannah, GA, and Folsom, NJ.

He was an icon in the architectural precast industry. He went from a tiny producer to an industry powerhouse. At one point, Universal Concrete was the largest producer in the country. He was well known for his generosity both professionally and personally. He was active in the Precast Concrete Institute and served over 2 decades on the PCI Board of Directors.

He was most proud of Universal's work on the Air Traffic Control Towers at Miami and Orlando, at one time, the two tallest in North America, the "Beer Can" building, the NCNB, in Tampa and the Citizen's Bank Park in Philadelphia.

He was a self-proclaimed workaholic and after retirement founded the Spring Street Bake Shop, a whole sale bakery, providing gourmet cookies to specialty stores in the Northeast region.

He is preceded in death by his wife Anastasia.

His survivors are his seven children, 16 grandchildren, and 2 great grandchildren.

Visitation will be held Thursday, September 21st, from 9:30-10:45 AM at St. Columbkil Roman Catholic Church, 200 Indian Spring Rd., Boyertown, PA 19512.

A Funeral Mass will follow at 11:00 AM at the church.

Interment will be held at Fairview Cemetery, Boyertown.
