He served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War, was honorably discharged and attended Indiana Institute of Technology. He joined Navistar International, formerly known as International Harvester Company. In 1955 he retired from there as a Project Engineer in 1993 after 38 years of service and moved to Sarasota, Florida the same year.

He was a life member of the American Legion and a Past Commander of Post 30 in Sarasota and a Past District Commander for the Dept. of Florida. He was a life member of the Elks Lodge 155 in Fort Wayne Indiana and a past Exalted Ruler. Later he became a member of the Elks Lodge 1519 in Sarasota.
