



Douglas Allen Wright

November 25, 1950 - October 13, 2024

Fisherman and veteran Douglas Allen Wright passed of a heart attack on Sunday, October 13th, at the PAM Health Specialty Hospital of Sarasota where he was receiving treatment. Born on November 25th, 1950, he was 73 years old. He lived full time in Port Charlotte, Florida, but was born in Gratiot County, Michigan, a county which his family helped found in the mid-1800s.

After leaving home, Douglas joined the Army and gave the country over two decades of service. He travelled the world over, both serving in and visiting places such as Vietnam; Japan; Korea; and many parts of Europe. On retiring from the service for the third and final time, he spent time as mailman for the USPS before his early retirement. He spent the remainder of his days in Florida, fishing, reading, playing video games, and spending time with his family.

He is survived by his daughter, Alana; his stepdaughter Amy; his sister Brenda; his brother Dennis; and his cousins Ron and Deb; as well as many other loving cousins, nieces, and nephews. He was preceded in death by his daughters DeeAnn and Karen; his parents Wendell and Dessie; and his brothers David and Barry.

Douglas will be interred at the Sarasota National Cemetery, where a service will be held November 15th at 2pm. All who would like to remember him are

welcome.

A second informal service will also be held in Michigan soon after.
