Dr. Alan Richard Treiman, born April 2nd 1954, passed away on April 17th, 2017, after a brave battle with cancer.

He will be missed by his beloved wife Lenore, his children Daniel and Nicole, his father Stanley, sister Phyllis and brother-in-law Neil, niece and nephew Erin and Harrison, and many other loving relatives and friends.

After graduating from Franklin and Marshall College he received his medical degree from Duke University in 1980. He then completed his general surgery training at New York Hospital Cornell Medical Center and Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York. He did his Urology training at the Harvard Program in Urology based at Brigham and Women's Hospital and Boston Children's Hospital, after which he settled in Sarasota to build his practice and his family. He will live on through memories of his sense of humor, his many outdoor hobbies, his deep knowledge of subjects ranging from art to fly fishing, and his unwavering love for friends and family.
