



## Dr. George Wallace Letchworth

September 20, 1927 - August 13, 2017

Wallace lived a long and multi-faceted life. Born in Sebastian, Florida, he served his nation in the US Army from 1946-1949. After returning home, Wallace, a member of the Sigma Chi fraternity, graduated from the University of Florida in 1950. With the assistance of U.S. Senator George Smathers, whom he worked for in Washington D.C., Wallace was admitted to the University of Miami medical school and graduated in 1958. He was one of the first residents at Shand's Hospital in Gainesville, Florida. He received his doctorate in Obstetrics and Gynecology and began practicing after he and wife Jane moved to Sarasota in 1963. During his long tenure at Sarasota Memorial Hospital, he brought more than a thousand babies into this world. Respected by his peers and loved by his patients, Wallace was the consummate physician.

Wallace was devoted to his family. With his wife of 60 years, Jane (Snow), he had daughter Karen Letchworth Dearth and son Lance Letchworth . His grandchildren, Kristin Dearth, Luke Letchworth and Logan Letchworth were the light of his life. And nothing made him happier than when they visited. He loved sharing his wisdom with them and appreciated each of their special gifts.

Gardening was also a big part of his life, which is on full display both at his home and at Selby Gardens, where some of his Bonsai trees still reside. A

founding member of the Sho Fu Bonsai Society, he was also a supporter of the Ringling Museum, especially the Asian Arts division. An active member of the Field Club for many years he also served as its chair of admissions.

Wallace was pre-deceased by his parents Rabun and Viola Letchworth, his sister Jane, and his brothers Forrest and William.

A memorial service will be held 1:00 PM Wednesday August 23, 2017 at Toale Brothers Funeral Homes, Colonial Chapel, 40 N. Orange Avenue, Sarasota, FL 34236
