After raising their children, Micki worked for Eastern Airlines in Woodbridge, N.J., and later transferred to Miami in 1972 where she retired in 1992. She was extremely proud of her work at Eastern Airlines - she worked hard and rose through the ranks to become a supervisor.

They were wonderful parents who supported their children's pursuits and interests with love without interference.

They both loved music, the arts, and traveling. Micki was an excellent cook, crossword puzzle junkie, and prolific list maker. Ed loved Wagner, Jazz, and pontificating.

Micki and Ed were also devoted grandparents who shared their interests and love with their grandchildren.

Micki died unexpectedly in June of 2017. Ed died in May of 2025 at the ripe old age of 96. Their only son, Scott, died unexpectedly while traveling in London with his wife Lori in September of 2024.
