Edward C. Cook, 86, of Sarasota, passed away August 20, 2017.

Born in Worcester, MA, on January 25, 1931, he grew up in Endicott, NY, attending Union-Endicott High School. He graduated from Harpur College (now Binghamton University) in 1953, where he met his wife of 61 years, Constance Bartlett. In 1954/1955 he served in the US Army in Korea. He worked for 36 years for IBM as a Business Manager, primarily in the New York City area and resided for most of this time in Fair Lawn, NJ. In 2000, he and his wife retired to Sarasota, where he was active in the choir of St. Thomas More church. His wife died in 2015.
