Dr. Edward Hartenian passed away on Sunday, May 30, 2021 in Sarasota, FL, at the age of 99.

Born in Cincinnati, he graduated from Withrow High School in 1939. He then attended Denison university where he received his Bachelor's Degree and was a member and president of Lambda Chi Alpha. Following that he obtained his Doctorate from University of Cincinnati college of Medicine. He then served his country in the Army Medical Corp before getting his post-graduate in Anesthesiology from Georgetown.

Edward was a member of the American Medical Association as well as the American, Ohio and Cincinnati Societies of Anesthesia. He practiced in Cincinnati both privately and on the staff of numerous hospitals, and was Director of Anesthesiology at Christ Hospital for over 30 years.

He was an avid reader and never missed a day doing a crossword puzzle. Edward also enjoyed tennis, golf and travel and knew a large repertoire of music which he played by ear on his piano.

While living in Cincinnati he was a member of HPCC for more than 40 years, serving not only on the Board of Directors but also as President.

After retiring he moved to Sarasota and became a member of the Tournament Players Club (TPC) at Prestancia. By the time he gave up golf at 97, he had three hole-in-ones to his credit, at 82, 85 and 93 years of age.

Edward was preceded in death by his father, mother and sister. He is survived by his wife 45 years, Luella, and her daughters, Laura and Elizabeth Baron and grandson Mark Edward Baron. Also, his daughter Melanie Fish and niece Gay Anderson and their families.

There will be no formal service.

Interment will be July 9th at 10:00am at Sarasota National Cemetery, 9810 State Road 72, Sarasota, Fl 34241, in the Wall of Honor.
