



Elizabeth Loretta Lambroussis

May 11, 1921 - April 28, 2018

Elizabeth Loretta Lambroussis, 96, died on April 28, 2018 in Sarasota, FL. She was born in Dublin, Ireland on May 11, 1921, and is survived by her husband Harry, nieces Pat, Linda Gail, Sheila, Una, and several grand-nieces and nephews.

She was the 4th of 5 children of her parents James and Maria Hoey.

During World War II, in the Battle of Britain, she served as a volunteer with the British Red Cross. Her brother Girard also fought with the RAF as an ace fighter pilot, and received a royal decoration at the end of the war.

She received her secondary education at a Catholic Nun's school in Dublin.

She emigrated to America in 1947, and became a U.S. citizen in 1948.

During her working years, Loretta practiced journalism; she wrote for the Bermuda Mid-Ocean News during the period of 1955-1957, and for the Houston Post, as features reporter, during 1960-1964.

Following Harry's work assignments, she lived in Bombay (now Mumbai), India during 1964-1967, and in Sao Paulo, Brazil during 1969-1982. She lived in Sarasota since 1999.
