Faye Miller Luft, 69, was called to her eternal home on April 27, 2017 (after a long illness, with family at her side, with her husband at her side)

Faye was born in Waukesha, Wisconsin and grew up in LaCrosse, Wisconsin, graduating from Onalaska Luther High School. She began her career as an inhalation Therapy Technician in 1968, and later graduated from Biosystems Institute as a Respiratory Therapist. She worked at Gundersen Clinic and Lutheran Hospital in LaCrosse until 1986.

That year she and her husband, Tom, moved to Sarasota, Florida where she worked at Sarasota Memorial Hospital until 2015. During that time, Faye also worked as a long distance flight therapist, transporting patients to or from Manila, Uruguay, Venezuela, Canada, and many US states. After treatment for breast cancer in 1999, Faye became involved in raising money in the fight against cancer, participating in many walks and runs, including the Komen 3 Day, 60 mile breast cancer walk for 7 years. Faye was also a member of Ascension Evangelical Lutheran Church. Survivors include her husband: Tom, 2 sons: Kevin M. McDowell of LaCrosse, Wi. And Corey W. McDowell of Bay City, Michigan, and 4 Grandchildren: Kevin McDowell, Jr, Anthony McDowell, Madison McDowell, and Kori Jae McDowell. She was preceded in death by her oldest son, Craig S.
