Felix Troiano was born June 9, 1931, in Medford, Massachusetts.

Growing up in a large family during the Depression, Felix's goal was to be an automobile mechanic. During his teen years, Felix worked at a garage after school and on weekends refining his technical skills.

When he was drafted into the U. S. Navy, Felix was assigned to Walter Reed National Military Medical Center in Bethesda, Maryland as a dental technician.

Following his honorable discharge from the Navy, Felix earned his degree in chemistry from Tufts University in Massachusetts. He built his career as chemist specializing in the development of adhesives; he also dabbled in real estate building homes.

Felix's hobbies included woodworking and ballroom dancing.

Following a 30-year friendship, Felix and Reina married in 2005. They lived in Nokomis, Florida until they moved to Plymouth Harbor in 2015.

At the age of 92 after a series of illnesses which Felix successfully and valiantly fought for many years,

Felix quietly and peacefully died in his sleep on October 14, 2023.
