Frances Caldwell Query, 102, of Sarasota Florida passed away peacefully on February 26, 2017. Her parents were Robert Sidney Query and Laura Godwin Query. Her only sibling was Robert Sidney Query Jr. deceased.

She is survived by her niece, Laurin Query Goldner and her husband Nelson Goldner. She is also survived by grandnieces, Melissa Grodi (Ben), Erin Walker (Joe) and grandnephew Robert McLendon and their children.

A native of Charlotte, North Carolina, she received her BA degree from Queens College in 1936 and her Masters in Religious Education in 1941 from the Presbyterian School of Christian Education in Richmond, VA. Her varied career included teaching English, French and Bible in public high schools in North Carolina and ecumenical work serving on staff or as director of the North Carolina Council of Churches, the National Council of Churches in New York City and the Greater Kansas City Council of Churches. From 1957-1961 she was the Dean of Students at Flora MacDonald College in North Carolina. She moved to Decatur, Georgia with her mother in 1961 to work for the Protestant Radio and Television Center until 1971. From then until she retired in 1984, she was employed at the Presbyterian Survey Center continuing her service to the Presbyterian Church.

She joined North Decatur Presbyterian Church in 1961 and served faithfully

as a ruling elder, member of the pastor search committee, Sunday school teacher, Circle Bible leader and as a visitor to shut-ins.

A memorial service to remember Frances will take place at North Decatur Presbyterian Church and will be announced at a later date.
