Frank moved to Sarasota with his wife and family in 1969 and began work as a teacher with the Sarasota school district. He was a graduate of Central Connecticut State College. He graduated from Southern Connecticut State with a MS in guidance and a six-year certificate in administration from Fairfield university. Frank worked as a guidance counselor and was Director of Career Education for Sarasota County. In 1976 he left the school system to serve as Vice President and Director of Personnel and Human Services at Coast Federal Savings and Loan. He returned to serve as Director of Personnel for the school district. He finished his career at Sarasota high school and the Vocational Technical Institute where he retired June 30, 1995.

He was a NASCAR fan and enjoyed driving his red Firebird. He began playing Pickleball back in the 70s with its founder and continued to play softball into his late 70s.

He is survived by Lucy his wife of 67 years, two daughters, a daughter-in-law,

six grandchildren, and five great grandchildren.
