



Frederick John Gesiorski

February 17, 1946 - April 8, 2026

Frederick John Gesiorski, 80, passed away peacefully at his home April 8, 2026, in Parrish, Florida with his beloved wife Eula at his side.

Fred was a loving husband to Eula (Overbey) Gesiorski, devoted father to his two children, Douglas (Carrie) Gesiorski of Denver, Colorado and Stefanie Gesiorski of Santa Rosa, California, and a much-loved uncle, brother-in-law, and friend.

Fred was born in Dettelbach, Germany on February 17, 1946. The second child of Polish immigrants who came to the United States in 1949, he grew up in Chicago, Illinois.

Fred graduated from University of Illinois, where he met Eula in 1967. The two married in 1970. He later earned his MBA from University of Pennsylvania in 1997.

Fred and Eula relocated multiple times, from Chicago to Philadelphia, to Houston, Florida, and even more places in between, making friends everywhere they went. Fred had a particularly strong connection to Paoli Presbyterian Church in Pennsylvania, where he sang in the choir and served as an Elder. As a member of the Parish Life Committee, he was known for his colorful, costumed announcements from the pulpit.

While Fred could be reserved and quiet, his kindhearted nature and quirky (sometimes corny!) sense of humor were evident to those who got the chance to know him.

Fred had a long career in finance, including 12 years at ARCO Chemical followed by 10 years at LyondellBassell. Despite the dry nature of financial reporting, tales of Fred's infamous Star Wars-themed presentations are still told today.

Fred was preceded in death by his mother Katharina (Nowak) Gesiorski, his father Stanislaus Gesiorski, and his brothers Ludwig Gesiorski and Stanley Gesiorski.

A celebration of life memorial service will be held on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, from 3-5pm at the Heritage Hills Clubhouse, 3195 Heritage Hills Blvd, Clermont, FL.
