George De Genaro died on August 8 at home at Bay Plaza in downtown Sarasota. He was 93. His illness was short with wonderful caregivers. George, born in New Haven, CT, was the sixth child and fifth son of his immigrant parents. At 17, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy in December 1941. With the G.I. Bill, he graduated from Wesleyan University and Yale Law School.

He practiced law in New York City at Sullivan and Cromwell and Shea and Gould. Retiring in 1989, he studied painting with Arthur Getz, well-known cover artist of The New Yorker Magazine. George's paintings hang in homes and galleries and restaurants across America.

He and his wife, Mary Jane Lloyd, lived in Manhattan, Greenwich CT, Roxbury CT and eventually Boca Grande, FL before moving to Sarasota in 2000.
