Gerard P. "Jerry" O'Malley, 82, of Venice, formerly of New Jersey passed away December 24, 2017. Jerry was born on June 15, 1935 to James and Margaret (Kenneally) O'Malley in West Orange, NJ.

A graduate of West Orange High School, Jerry attended Cornell University, University of Hawaii, Columbia University, and graduated from Upsala College, where he was a member of the Zeta Psi fraternity.

He served his country in the U.S. Army. Jerry was an executive for Remington Rand Corporation working in industrial plastics, and was involved in the development of what would become the first standard cabinet for the computer industry.

He enjoyed little theater, with lead roles in 2 Chatham Players shows in Chatham, NJ.

Jerry also enjoyed playing golf at the Kahkwa Club in Erie, PA, North Ridge in Raleigh, NC, and Plantation Golf & Country Club in Venice.

Because of his military service, Jerry also served as Commander of the Jacaranda Trace Veterans Club.

He is survived by his beloved wife Judith (Kistner), sons Kevin and wife Wendy (Hall), Keane and wife Mary(Plant), and Kerry and wife Kris (Etter), and grandchildren Ryan, Megan (O'Malley) Haug, and Shannon.

Jerry will be laid to rest with honors in Sarasota National Cemetery at 1:30pm on Friday, January 12, 2018.
