Glen E Robertson 88 of Sarasota, Fl passed away peacefully on April 19, 2016.

Glen was born in Fairland, Illinois on March 18, 1928 and graduated from the University of Illinois, Class of 48' for electrical engineering. Distinguished military service in the Air force 1094th Squadron "Nuclear Command". He received commendation from his commanding general. Glen also owned and operated Louisquissett Pike Nursey of N. Smithfield, RI for a number of years before founding Mini Systems Inc. N. Attleboro, Massachusetts in 1968. M.S.I. is a world class leader for Micro-Hybrid electronics. Mr. Robertson was also a pioneer in the GPS industry when he invented the Rhodan Marine GPS anchoring system. Glen was also a lifelong member of the Elks club and a 33rd degree member of the Scottish Rite.
