



## H. "Clay" Kurtnacker

December 12, 1916 - January 22, 2016

H. "Clay" Kurtnacker, 99, passed away on January 22, 2016, in Tulsa, Ok. Clay was the fifth of 10 children born to John G. and Naomi Kurtnacker on December 12, 1916. He was born in Latonia, Ky., and moved with his family to Sarasota at two to three years of age.

He loved Sarasota, but moved to Tulsa in 2006 to be near his two daughters. Clay was a WWII vet, he served in the Navy from 1942-1945, and was especially proud of his service to his country. He was the original owner of Kurtnacker Roofing and roofed countless homes and businesses in Sarasota for almost 40 years.
