



## Jack Charles Blundell

June 11, 1938 - August 6, 2024

Jack Charles Blundell, aged 86, of Venice, FL, passed away on August 6, 2024. Born on June 11, 1938, in Superior, Wisconsin, Jack, as he was affectionately known, dedicated his life to the service of others through his skilled work as a Prosthodontist and his deep faith in Jesus Christ.

Matt Blundell (Marnie wife). He was preceded in death by his wife, Judy Blundell. Jack's legacy of faith, love, and service will continue to live on in the hearts of those he touched.
