Jack C. Bryant passed away on July 6, 2024, at the age of 97.

Jack was born in Lakeland, FL to General Lee and Rosa Bryant. At the age of six he moved with his family to Sarasota. Jack graduated from Sarasota High School and Auburn University. He joined the Army Air Corps after graduation from Auburn and later returned to Sarasota where he married the late Clara Mae Horne in 1949 and raised their three children. He later married Martha (Marti) Jenkins. He was pre-deceased by his daughter, Georgia Anne Spear and his son, Gregg Lee Bryant.

Jack began a 50-year career at Logan and Curran Contractors ultimately becoming its owner and CEO. He was awarded “Contractor of the Year” twice by the Gulf Coast Builders Exchange. He retired in 1997 to give more time to his beloved Shriners.

Jack was a 33 Degree Mason (Masons Worldwide). He was instrumental in the development of the “Flying Fez”. They facilitate the transportation of local children to Shriner’s Hospitals. Jack was invited into the prestigious “Royal Order of the Quetzalcoatl” and later earned an invitation to the OKET. Later he was invited into the “Royal Order of Jesters”.

Jack was also a member of the “Quiet Birdman”.
