John F Feagan, 94, of Venice, FL, formerly of Chicago, IL, and Mobile, AL, passed away March 3, 2017 in Venice.

John was a WWII Veteran, serving in the 14th Fighter Squadron of the Third Air Force training pilots on the P-47 Thunderbolt at Venice Army Airfield. He married Bette Myers of Middletown, NY in 1945 and after being honorably discharged, worked for Armour & Co. and Delchamps, retiring in 1987 as a CFO.

He was an accomplished athlete playing golf and tennis, winning the Alabama State Doubles Tennis Championship, 55 and Over. John was also a lifelong Chicago sports fan, delighted to see the Cubs finally win the 2016 World Series. He was beloved by his family for his generosity, kindness, humor, and great storytelling.

Predeceased by his wife Bette and his daughter Carol, he is survived by his brother Walter E. Feagan (Cathy) of Phoenix, AZ; his other three children John M.
