Dr. John "Jack" T. Hart was born December 10, 1928, in New Brunswick, NJ and passed away on February 24, 2024, in Lakewood Ranch, Florida after a brief illness after being in rehab for a hip fracture.

He was a retired Physician of Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology. His education included: New Brunswick High School in NJ, graduating with the National Honor Society; Rutgers University with a B.S. in Biology as a distinguished Military Student; Air Force; ROTC; George Washington School of Medicine; being 16th in a class of 79; Internship at Philadelphia General Hospital and Residency there also. He was in the US Air Force at Johnson Air Force Base in Japan where he was Chief of Medicine and then at Andrews Air Force Base in Washington D.C. as Chief of Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology. Dr. Hart was in Private Practice from July 1964 to 1994 in New Brunswick, NJ and Manasquan NJ when he retired.

He had 30 years of experience in upper GI Endoscopy and 20 years of experience in Colonoscopy.
