John P. McMorrow, (87), of Venice, Florida passed away at home on March 14, 2025.

John was born September 19, 1937, in Dobbs Ferry, NY to Martin and Mary Kate McMorrow. He attended Dobbs Ferry Elementary School and Stepinac High School. He graduated from Fordham University in 1959 with a B.A. in Economics.

From 1960-1964, he was an Officer in the U.S. Navy, serving as a Deck Division Officer on the USS Saratoga, a Military Advisor in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia, and Base Security Officer at the USN Communications Station in Cheltenham, MD.

On completion of his service, he joined Bell Laboratories as an analyst working first in New York City and then in New Jersey. He transferred to AT&T Corporate Headquarters in 1972, holding increasingly responsible positions over a 25-year period, retiring in 1997 as Vice President Human Resources.

He was President and CEO of Talent Alliance, a not-for-profit alliance of businesses using the Internet for employee training from 1998-2000.

John married Diana M. Moon in 1977. They lived in Bernardsville, New Jersey, Chicago, Illinois, and Bozeman, Montana prior to moving to Venice.

John was an enthusiastic golfer playing throughout the United States, England, Scotland and Ireland. He enjoyed road cycling and skiing. He was an avid reader of mysteries, particularly those by British and Scandinavian authors as well as non-fiction history and travel works. During retirement, he and Diana traveled extensively and pursued their joint interests in theatre, music and dance.

He is survived by his wife, Diana; sister, Mary (Michael) Sandak of Chestnut Ridge, New York; his stepsons Maxwell (Belinda) Moon of Osprey, Florida; and Alan R. (Janet) Moon of New Orleans, LA.
