Joseph D'Aiuto, 91, of Sarasota, FL formerly of Venice, FL passed away June 9, 2017. He was Born in Bridgeport, Ct. on January 20, 1926, he was the son of the late Nicholas D'Aiuto and the late Jennie Pappano D'Aiuto.

Joseph graduated from Bassick High School in 1943 and enlisted in The United States Army Air Force in 1944 where he served until 1946.

After his military service, he attended Hartt School of Music from 1946 to 1948 and then attended Bridgeport Engineering Institute where he earned his Associate Degree in Engineering. Joseph worked as a designer at Sikorsky Aircraft and Perkin Elmer.

As a pianist, he traveled with the Frank Wojnarski Polka Band from 1950 to 1952 and played with local dance bands.

After living in Trumbull and Stratford, Ct. Joseph moved to Venice, Florida in 1989 where he lived at the Plantation. In 1994, he moved to Timberwood in Sarasota shortly later moved to Lake Shore Village before moving to Lakehouse West.

Joseph played locally and volunteered weekly at the Venice Senior Center for 20 years.

Joseph is survived by his sister, Evelyn D'Aiuto of Sarasota, cousins, Marie Parisi of Trumbull, CT, Vito D'Aiuto of Huntington, CT, several cousins in Connecticut and many friends.

A memorial mass will be held Monday, June 19, 2017, 10:00 am at St. Thomas More Catholic Church, 2506 Gulf Gate Drive, Sarasota, Florida 34231 with the interment to follow the service in the church garden.
