



## Joyce M. Barstow

January 21, 1931 - January 17, 2016

Joyce McLean Barstow died Sunday, January 17, 2016, after a long illness, four days shy of her eighty-fifth birthday. Joyce was born in New Straitsville, Perry County, Ohio, the daughter of John Stace McLean and Bridget Murphy McLean.
