On Wednesday, August 10, 2022, Jud Curwood passed away at age 73. Jud was born on July 18, 1949, in Sarasota Florida to Gerald and Helen Curwood. He was raised in Venice and was a 1967 graduate of Venice High School.

Jud owned his own business, Curwood Carpentry, for approximately 40 years.
