Katarina (Kate) Fried, age 94, of Glenridge, Sarasota, FL. Wife of the late Dr. Vojtech Fried. Companion of the late Dr. George Gitlitz. Mother of Dr. Thomas (Sharon) Fried. Grandmother of Dr. Ora Fried (Scott Froom) and Rabbi Benjamin (Estie) Fried. Great grandmother of Jonah and Guy Froom, Baruch, Yosef, Yedidya, Sarah, Temimah, and Emunah Fried. Katarina was the daughter of the late Eduard and Olga Altmann and was raised in Liptovsky Mikulas, Slovakia. She, her husband and son resided in Prague and fled Communism in 1964. The family moved to New York where Dr. Fried became Professor of Physical Chemistry at Brooklyn College.

After moving to Sarasota in the 1990's, Katarina became involved in Holocaust education and was honored by the Florida Holocaust Museum.
