Louis Lazerow, age 97, passed away in Glenview, IL. He was born in New London, CT, the son of Jacob and Elizabeth Lazerow. Following the loss of his first wife, Regina, he moved to Sarasota, FL in 1995 and subsequently met and married Bernice Caplan, who passed away in 2016. Louis will be lovingly missed by his sons, David Lazerow and Stephen (Betsy) Lazerow; grandchildren, Katrina Lazerow and Henry Lazerow; two great granddaughters; and sister, Shirley Sherman.
