Marcia Gayle Woodward, age 85, of Sun City Center, FL, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, March 12, 2026, at Sarasota Point Rehabilitation Center in Sarasota, FL.

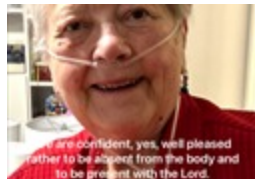
