



Marjorie Mapes Brett Boulware

July 4, 1917 - July 7, 2018

Marjorie Mapes Brett Boulware of Sarasota, age 101, died on July, 7, 2018. She was born in East Orange, New Jersey, on July 4, 1917. A private memorial service was held on July 11, 2018.

Marjorie grew up in Glen Ridge, New Jersey and attended Centenary Junior College and Skidmore College. She married Roger W. Brett in 1940. They lived in Schenectady, NY, Bridgeport, CT, Kansas City, MO, and Longboat Key, FL. In Kansas City, she was an active volunteer in her church, the Red Cross, the Girl Scouts and Gillis Home. In Sarasota, she was a volunteer at Sarasota Memorial Hospital for 38 years and a member of the Bird Key Yacht Club. She and her husband Roger, who died in 1985, were avid sailors. She also enjoyed swimming, gardening and bridge.

In 1995, she married G. William W. Boulware (Bill), a longtime friend from Kansas City. They spent their time between Longboat Key and Kansas City until they moved into Plymouth Harbor in 2000. Bill died in 2007.

Marjorie is survived by her two daughters, Judy B. Thompson (Charles Thompson) and Jeanne M. Brett (Stephen Goldberg), six grandchildren, eight great grandchildren and two stepsons and their families.
