Mark Lawrence Goslin born June 11, 1950 in Iowa City, IA, to Dr. Fred and Marilyn Forsythe Goslin. He departed this earth on May 30, 2023 in Sarasota, FL.

He is preceded in death by his parents; his sister, Dr. Teri Goslin; and his brother, Scott Goslin.

He is survived by his loving wife Robin Sutcliffe; his sons, Mark Travis and Joshua John Goslin; 6 grandchildren, and 3 great grandchildren.

He graduated from Newman HS in Iowa in 1968, and from Central Missouri State University with a BS in Criminal Justice Administration. He served 3 years as a police officer in Independence, MO before joining the US Air Force as a Security Police Officer in 1977 with assignments in Texas, California, Nebraska, New Mexico, North Dakota, Korea, and Virginia. During that time, he received an MS in Criminal Justice Administration from California State University in Sacramento. During his first assignment, he met and later married the love of his life, Robin Sutcliffe. His AF career included duties as Shift Commander, Operations Officer, Training Staff Officer for the Security Police Career Field; Staff Officer, commander, and was Chief of Police at Mather AFB, CA and also Minot AFB, ND. He was Deputy Provost Marshall for the Army in South Korea. Colonel Goslin retired from the AF as Deputy

Director of Security Forces for the Air Combat Command at Langley AFB, VA in 2003.

He enjoyed singing, SCUBA diving, horsemanship, tennis, traveling, snow skiing, and was very involved as an elder of Northminster Presbyterian Church serving as Worship chairman and as a primary singer for the praise team for over a decade. In Sept of 2022, he was inducted into the Iowa Rock 'n Roll Music Association for a band he was in in 1967-68.
