Maurice K. Albritton (née Gough) passed away in Sarasota, Florida on August 11, 2017 at the age of 93.

It was in Sarasota that they raised their family. J.K. started Albritton Fuel Oil Company and Maurice took care of the bookkeeping end of the business. They lived in Sarasota until retirement when they moved back Hardee County.

Both were active in Bay Haven Baptist Church in Sarasota. After they moved back to Wauchula they joined and were active in First Baptist Church of Wauchula, Florida. Maurice's greatest joys were the time spent with J.K. and her family.
