Michael J. Brassard, 78, of Sarasota, FL passed away on November 27, 2021.

He was born on January 15 1943 in Northfield, VT to Clarence and Marion Brassard. Brassard was many things - father, brother, entrepreneur, friend and renowned raconteur. Mostly, though, it was his generosity of spirit and larger than life presence that's recalled by all who knew him.

Brassard owned numerous businesses throughout the years, including various Midas muffler shops in New York and Vermont. While Brassard was known as a successful entrepreneur, he also harbored creative aspirations both as a painter and as a musician. He was as a world-class singer, having fronted numerous rock 'n' roll bands since the late 1950s, including the legendary pre-Beatles outfit, Mike & The Ravens. His other musical endeavors included managing and producing the late Bryan Harvey's first band, The Dads, as well as a partnership with a musical giant, Paul Leka.

Brassard was predeceased by a son, Stephen, and leaves a loving wife, Janet, and beloved daughter, Liisa as well as two brothers, John and David, and two sisters, Chloe and Judy.
