Michael Joseph Holsinger passed away October 17, 2016 at the age of 79.

Born in Dayton, Ohio, Mike was a 20 year career officer in the US Air Force and decorated Vietnam Veteran having earned The Bronze Star. After retiring from the military, Mike returned to the University of Missouri to earn a Master's degree in Ornamental Horticulture.

In 1986 Mike and his devoted bride Sharon moved to Sarasota to begin his 20 year career with Sarasota County and the University of Florida as Director for County Extension Department.

Mike's crowning achievement was his pivotal role in vision, design, and successful establishment of "The Florida House" in Sarasota as a model for sustainable and environmentally responsible construction. Mike was an accomplished writer with published articles during his tour in Vietnam, as well the Sarasota Herald Tribune with articles on horticulture, ornamental/non toxic landscaping and beautification.

His two passions in life were fishing and gardening and these loves are carried on by his wife and children.

Mike was an active member of St. Michael's Catholic Church with Sharon. He

served as a lay member of the Bishop's Archdiocese Planning and Development Council and was a former member of Sarasota Fruit and Nut Society. Mike worked in retirement as a horticultural consultant to numerous individuals and associations.

Mike is survived by his wife of 56 years, Sharon, children Jeffrey (Beth), Jamie (John) Barron, and Joseph (Sarah) in addition to 4 grandchildren.

Services will be held at 10:00 am on November 18 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Sarasota on Siesta Key, followed by a military burial at Sarasota National Cemetery at 1:00 pm.
